

We are a group of around 40 Christians, most of whom live in or around the Fishguard Road housing estate in Llanishen, North Cardiff. Our church family ranges from infants to those in their 90s.

We meet in the church building which is just south of the park in the middle of the Fishguard Road estate.

We believe that the news about Jesus Christ is the best and most important news there is to hear. Each of us has a personal relationship with God and as a church we exist to worship God and to make the news about Jesus known in Llanishen, Wales and beyond.

What's on? Our Regular Events

Sundays

Sunday Morning Service

We meet at 10.30AM at the church building for our main weekly gathering. We sing, pray, read the Bible and hear it explained each week. Activities for primary school aged children take place in term time and a creche room is available weekly. Afterwards, we enjoy teas, coffees and cakes together.

Wednesdays

Community Coffee Morning (term time)

Come and join us at 10AM for teas, coffees and snacks whilst catching up with friends old and new. There's also a chance to hear a short talk about the message of hope found in the Bible.

Lunch & Look at the Bible (fortnightly)

A chance to find out more about Christianity by looking at a short Bible passage, followed by lunch together. We start at 11.30AM.

Prayer Meeting (fortnightly)

We meet together at 7.30PM to say thank you to God for all he's given us and to pray about the needs of the church family and the wider world.

Saturdays

Free Food Market (monthly)

Fill your shopping bags with surplus stock from local supermarkets at our Free Food Market which opens at IOAM on the first Saturday of each month.
